Effective April 8, 2020

In THE CITY OF BRADENTON BEACH has supported and recommended the practice social distancing per Governor DeSantis in Executive Order #20-83 and the Florida Department of Health Office of the Surgeon General. Pursuant to Executive Order 20-91 and Article II of the City Charter, this is a directive clarifying and the application of City of Bradenton Beach Resolution 20-929.

The City of Bradenton Beach may avail itself of any resources provided by FEMA, the State of Florida or Manatee County to assist and provide for the sheltering of those deemed to be homeless. This Directive shall not prevent law enforcement from applying any Federal, State or local laws to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

Resolution 20-929 shall not be applied in a manner that interferes with the Constitutional rights of the public and its citizenry.

This Directive shall be attached as a supplement to Resolution 20-929.
