CITY OF BRADENTON BEACH DIRECTIVE: #8

Effective May 22, 2020

On or about March 17, 2020, the City of Bradenton Beach declared a State of Local Emergency related to the Coronavirus Disease 2019. Accordingly, the City has supported and recommended the practice of social distancing per Governor DeSantis in Executive Order #20-83 and the Florida Department of Health Office of the Surgeon General. Pursuant to Executive Order 20-91, Article II of the City Charter, and Ordinance 07-399, this is a directive to safeguard the citizenry from large social gatherings.

I HEREBY DIRECT THAT ALL SPECIAL EVENT APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED BY THE CITY OF BRADENTON BEACH FOR THE DURATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-52, DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR THE ENTIRE STATE OF FLORIDA AS A RESULT OF COVID-19.
